"...so is my word that goes out from my mouth: It will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it."


#### Isaiah 55:11, NIV

God's visible power is at work today through accelerated, indigenous-led Bible translation. Over half the task is complete as the Great Commission horizon comes into view.

Roughly 3,000 language groups remain—but it's happening: God's Word reaches even the most remote and hostile areas.

Our translation team is so inspired by the response from our community! Many locals read the translated Scripture, and for most of them, it was the first time they had ever seen a book written in their language. These villagers had never even imagined that such a thing could be possible."

# UNEXPECTED PEOPLE unexpected places

Across the globe, Spirit-led translators answer God's call. The Word for the World equips these gospel workers, while partners and churches join in, together driving a nimble, organic movement of Bible translation in unexpected places.

Few expected a Roma woman from Serbia's Čergar community to help bring God's Word to her people. For generations, the Čergar carried rejection and misunderstanding. This Bibleless community longed for truth, yet God's Word remained out of reach.

As a pastor's wife, Biljana watched her community suffer and cried out for a way forward.In 2011, this faith-filled woman prayed for a miracle: the Bible in Čergar. God answered with a clear call to take up translation.

Opposition and setbacks followed, but this determined servant pressed on, convinced God would provide. In time, He opened the door through The World for the World This passionate Bible student stepped into a team of nine men as the only woman. Far from sidelined, she offered theological and linguistic insight that shaped the work.

Training sharpened her skills, and perseverance carried the team through to a milestone: the New Testament, the first book ever written in the Čergar dialect.

Today, Roma families hold Scripture in their own language. Schools in Vojvodina teach Čergar for the first time. Communities read with joy, and many turn to Christ. Through the faith of an unexpected translator in an overlooked place, God speaks with power.
