Until recently, the Lambya of Malawi were among more than 3,000 language communities still waiting to read John 3:16 in their heart language.

Life in this mountainous area brought many obstacles, including blocked roads, no electricity, and few resources. Even printing translated Scripture seemed out of reach. Still, the Lambya team kept praying, trusting God to make a way.

Then provision came. Generous donors fully funded the project, opening the door for training, transportation, and essential tools.

With everything in place, the translators pressed ahead with renewed purpose.

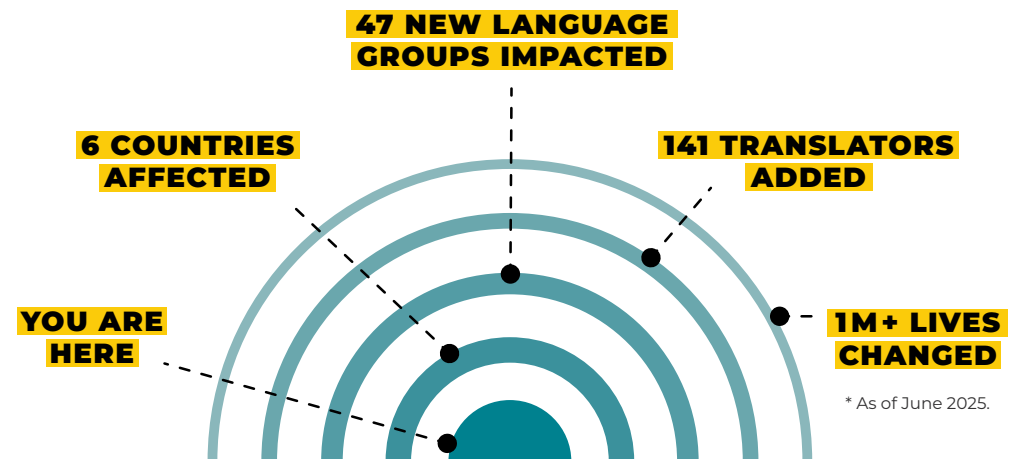
On April 26, the quiet town of Chitipa burst into song, thanksgiving, and joy during the Chilambya Bible launch. “It felt like heaven touched earth today,” said one woman.

Many wept, danced, or stood in awe. One young man said, Just knowing the Bible now exists in Chilambya gives me hope.”

Now, the Lambya hold God's Word, and transformation has begun.
